

Discovering an Asian Jewel

Laos is the least developed of the three former French Indochina colonies, while slowly setting up one of the most stable, low profile economic and political systems in the region.

We visited Laos in 2004 and 2014, when we travelled along Mekong river. We toured through this varied country by bus, taxi, boat and bicycle. Starting at the Thai border we reached Luang Prabang with its numerous sights. After visiting the scenic Vang Vieng area, we spent several days in the peaceful and quiet capital Ventiane.

Heading further South we travelled through impressive karst landscapes and dense jungle. At the border to Cambodia we admired the area of the "4000 Islands" featuring Khmer temples, towering waterfalls and idyllic villages situated at the banks of Mekong.
